

ORDINANCE NO. 86

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE I, SECTION 1.01(j), ARTICLE II, SECTION 2.05(a), AND ARTICLE V, SECTION 5.01(a) OF ORDINANCE NO. 36 OF HAMILTON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Hamilton Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that the above stated Ordinance is amended to include the following:

SECTION 1. Article I, Section 1.01(j) - "Sanitary Sewage" shall mean normal water-carried household and toilet wastes from any Improved Property, excluding such ground, surface or storm water as may be present.

SECTION 2. Article II, Section 2.05(a) - No building floor drain, sump pump, or any device permitting storm water, water table, or surface water to enter the Sewer shall be permitted.


SECTION 3. Article V, Section 5.01(a) - Any person who shall violate Section 2.05(a) of this Ordinance shall be liable, upon summary conviction, to a fine of not less than \$750.00 nor more than \$1,250.00.


SECTION 4. In all other respects, said Ordinance No. 36, as heretofore amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after enactment, as provided by law.

Enacted and ordained into an Ordinance this 15th day of May, 1990.


